### Category List

Middle Level and High School

1. **Ceramics (Functional)** – ceramics to be used in a functional way
2. **Ceramics (Non-Functional)** – ceramics created for aesthetic and sculptural value only
3. **Sculpture** – 3D art that is viewed “in the round” and void of clay
4. **Photography (Black and White)**– non altered digital or analog photographs
5. **Photography (color)**-non altered digital or analog photographs
6. **Drawing (Black and White)** – black and white drawings created on any paper by using charcoal, graphite, pen and ink, pencil, marker, etc.
7. **Drawing (Color)** – drawings that include color mediums such as colored pencil, chalk, oil pastels, markers, colored ink, etc.
8. **Painting**– Acrylic or Oil
9. **Painting** – Watercolor
10. **Digital Art** –computer based works of art
11. **Mixed Media** –art created with more than one medium  
***No fee required (in addition to your original entries you may have one free entry per teacher per category in the list below)***
12. **Jewelry** – art sculpture made for the purpose of adornment
13. **Printmaking** – art created by reproducing an image using printmaking techniques
14. **Fiber Art** – works made from paper or other fiber sources; weaving, batiks, silk paintings, wearable or non-wearable
15. **Commercial Art** – art that reflects any commercial aspect, such as but not limited to, advertising, layout, package design and illustration
16. **Altered Photographs** – techniques applied to photographs such as filters, sandwich prints and photo montages that utilize **ONLY** images that have been taken by the student
17. **Fashion Design** – Any art that revolves around the style of clothes, costumes and accessories (other than jewelry)
18. **Open**– just for the sake of art, anything that just does not fit a category above
